Preamble

This General License shall enable the user of the present work to make copies and modifications, to perform the work publicly and charge for exploitations at his discretion. Terms and Conditions

This license requires that the following terms of this license are adhered to, and, that this license or at least an incorporation of it by reference in the respective copy or modification of the work is brought to the attention of the public.
